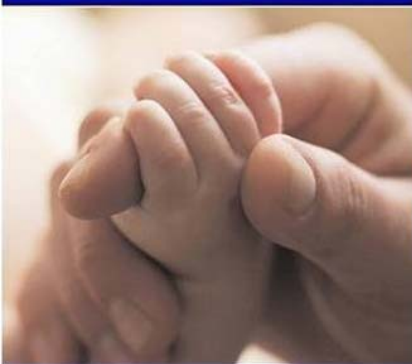
- An introduction to global principles from the Neurorelational Framework (Lillas & Turnbull, 2009)
