TERMS OF THE PROJECT

2. Is it your preference to find ONE consultant to fulfill your needs for both facilitation and report writing?

We see Task 1: Meeting Facilitation and Task 2: Report Research and Development as having two separate skill sets requiring two separate applications and anticipate entering into two separate agreements. However, we acknowledge that an individual or organization may have qualifications for both tasks. Proposers can apply for both tasks but are required to submit a separate application for each task. 

SCOPE OF WORK

6. Is there an opportunity or expectation for the engaged consultants to also provide subject matter expertise support to the NOC and peer-to-peer sessions?

The Report Research and Development Consultant (Task 2) is **expected and required** to provide subject matter expertise in drafting proceedings reports for NOC and Peer-to-Peer sessions and the Practice Paper.

TASK 1: MEETING FACILITATION

8. As part of the "support" for facilitation in the first paragraph of Task 1, will the consultant be responsible for facilitating the NOC Advisory and Planning group development and design activities leading up to the NOC convenings, will that be done collaboratively with, or will one of the partners have that responsibility (and which)?

It is expected that once the Meeting Facilitation consultant is onboarded, the consultant will take the lead in facilitating the advisory and planning group. The consultant will lead the codesign process of NOC sessions which includes developing activities to collaboratively plan for these NOC sessions with this group, as well as with First 5 LA and subject matter experts as needed. The consultant will then be responsible for facilitating the NOC sessions, implementing the focus and objectives that were co-designed with the planning group.

9. Is the NOC Advisory and Planning Group for your ACEs Aware grant already in place?

The NOC advisory and planning group comprised of cross-sector leaders from health plans, county departments, community-based organizations and school districts, has been established and will begin meeting prior to 2021.

10. Who will be responsible for recruiting the participants in both the NOC activities and the Peer-to-Peer Learning Sessions?

First 5 LA, in collaboration with our partners on this project, are responsible for recruiting NOC and Peer-to-Peer Learning session participants. The consultants are not expected or required to recruit the participants in both the NOC activities and the Peer-to-Peer Learning Sessions.

11. Does First 5 LA currently have a preferred videoconferencing platform that you regularly use and is part of your operating budget? Or would the research, support and fees associated with setting that up be the responsibility of the consultant?

There is no preferred videoconferencing platform, but we do regularly use certain platforms in our day-to-day work such as Microsoft Teams and Zoom. Any costs associated with a videoconferencing platform will be assumed by First 5 LA.

12. The RFQ does not mention the required ACEs Aware Provider Engagement Survey instrument for all engagement activity attendees - I assume First 5 LA will comply with this. Will the consultant also be responsible for administering that survey?

The consultant will be responsible for collecting required participant information and feedback via registration and evaluation surveys. It is expected that the consultant incorporate data elements required by ACEs Aware, such as the Provider Engagement Survey, to ensure that all necessary data are collected. Refer to Section IV. Scope of Work for Task 1 items #1 and #3 in the RFQ (pg. 8). Reporting templates will be provided to the consultant.
